MOTIONS AND ACTION ITEMS

1. Motion to establish two funding distribution models. The standard model will be utilized if all the five main host institutions (North Carolina State Univ., Univ. of Maryland Eastern Shore, Univ. of Florida, Michigan State Univ., Univ. of California-Davis) agree to waive the 10% indirect cost charges against total federal funds allowed. If the host institutions do not all agree to waive the indirect cost charges, modifications will be made. The modifications include reducing the core funds distributed to Northeast Region, Southern Region, and North Central Region by 10%, reduce the core funds to the Western Region by 5% and reduce the core funds for HQ by approx. 11%. The other component of this contingency would be to maintain the field residue trial funding allocation and modify (reduce) the funding for product performance, integrated solutions and environmental horticulture by 25%. **Approved.**
