



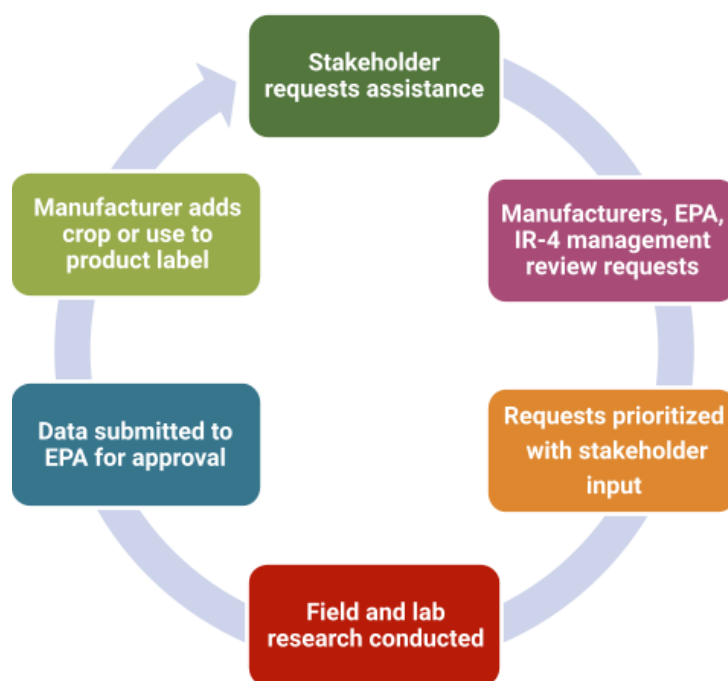
# IR-4's Research Cycle
